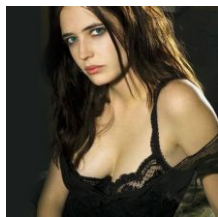

A new Bond girl has been chosen! The producers have finally decided who to play alongside Daniel Craig in the new Bond movie, "Casino Royale". The lucky one is French actress Eva. She will play Vesper Lynd opposite actor Daniel Craig as James Bond in Casino Royale, MGM and Sony Pictures Entertainment announced Thursday. The movie is set to hit theaters on November 17. Eva Green is the daughter of French actress Marlene Jobert and a Swedish dentist and she has a twin sister named Joy. Green made her film debut in Bernardo Bertolucci's "The Dreamers".
