[Amped: Freestyle Snowboarding - Cheats and Unlockables \(Xbox\)](#)

Conquer the mountains from your livingroom

"Amped: Freestyle Snowboarding" is the first snowboarding game focused on freestyle riding. Rip the ultimate line on wide-open real mountains packed with jumps and rails. Hit the cliffs, jib the rainbow tree rail or take the hidden path through the trees for a different ride every time. Pull insane tricks in front of roaming camera crews to get your face on video and magazine covers. Get enough international exposure to become one of the world's snowboarding media superstars.

Cheat mode:To get to the cheat menu, select "Options", then "Cheats". Note: You cannot save the game if cheats are enabled.

Level select, all costumes, gear, and snowboards.: Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter GimmeGimme as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Perfect jumps:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter StickiT as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Super spins:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter WhirlyGig as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Super statistics:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter BigsteeZ as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Low gravity:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter MegaLeg as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Play as Raven:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter RidinwRaven as a case-sensitive code to unlock Raven, the girl from the original Xbox tech demos and a Xbox snowboard. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Play as Steezy:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter ChillinwSteezy as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Disable tree collisions:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter buzzsaW as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Bouncy terrain:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter MegabOUnce as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Harder to do flips and spins:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter KeepnReal as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu.

Free movement:Select "Options" at the main menu, then "Cheats". Enter ZiPster as a case-sensitive code. A sound will confirm correct code entry. Press B to exit out of the cheat menu. You can move anywhere quickly, even going uphill.

View programmer replays:Enter the "Replay Theater" and highlight "Hard Disk". Press Right until "Game Disc" appears to find replays generated by the programmers. To play one of those levels, select a replay then highlight "Watch Replay". Press Right until you see "Challenge" appears, and then select it.

Bonus FMV sequences:Win all the Pro Challenges, get all the high scores, complete all media challenges, and find all eight snowmen on every level to reach World Rank #1. You will unlock a snowboarding trick video, the behind the scenes featurette, and the ending credits.

Rail control:Use the L and R to avoid falling off rails. Your rail stats will depend on how hard it is to control. This will give you very easy points.

Extra points: Tweaked grabs will give you more points. If you press the same trigger a lot of times while doing a grab trick, you will earn a lot of points. It is easiest to use the StaleFish and press R.

Easy front and back flips:While going off a jump (works best on West Ridge), hold B Left Analog-stick Up (for a front flip) or Left Analog-stick Down (for a back flip).

Finding snowmen:If you need help finding the snowmen on the different runs, try looking at the replays that appear during the game. The characters will sometimes hit one or two and reveal their locations.

Snowmen speaking:During game play, you will hear a strange, alien-like voice saying something similar to "bum, bu bu bu bum bu". This happens when you are near, or have just past, a snowman.

Bypass trick:Note: This only works about 75% of the time. On pro challenges, go slightly past (best when approaching from the side) the trick zones. Go uphill until it tells you to go down. If you go fast enough. it will still tell you to go downhill. If it is still flashing by the time you pass the trick zone you will not have to do the trick and you will not get a miss.
