## [Amy Winehouse Forgets About Birthday Boy Blake](#)

*The singer fails to visit her incarcerated husband on his birthday*

Amy Winehouse's husband Blake Fielder-Civil turned 26 yesterday - however, his beehived, crack-loving, Grammy-winning wife did not bother to grace her incarcerated better half with her presence, leaving Blaaaaake to entertain himself and find solace in his own jail cell at London's Pentonville prison. Which means one of two things: either Amy has finally seen the light and realized that her husband (who is currently in jail awaiting trial for attempting to pervert the course of justice) is a loser who contributed to her own downfall, or she was simply so drunk or stoned that she forgot about his anniversary.

Amy's own life has become increasingly chaotic ever since her drug habit made a grim comeback.
