Is the former model trying to earn a living off her daughter's back?

It seems that bad times are ahead for the former model and D-list celebrity Anna Nicole Smith. Rumor has it that both she and the man with whom she is sort of 'married' and who claims to be the father of Danielynn Hope are out of cash and that they're desperate enough as to do anything to get their greedy hands on some.
