A Reuters report, recently updated and corrected, says that **Apple is hiring** for the grand opening of several Apple **retail stores** in **Germany** and **Switzerland**. No doubt, the respective territories are packed full with people interested in purchasing Apple products, who, until now, could only order the consumer electronics, and seek advice via specialized websites, blogs and forums. Corrections to the original report were made upon the false mentioning of Apple seeking staff for opening a store in Ireland, as well (besides the previously mentioned European countries).
