## **Black Pearl Miniaturized by Haier America**

The Black Pearl features an MP3 player ready to play all your favorite songs, which can be stored on a [TransFlash](#) card of up to 1 gigabyte that can be crammed into its memory expansion TransFlash card slot, an FM tuner for all of you that like to listen to the favorite radio station while on-the-go, a voice recorder, a quite improbable 3D graphics chipset, an [OLED](#) screen display, a thumb rocker, stereo Bluetooth, and miniUSB support. If you go over its dimensions, and the necessity of very small finger tips to operate this handset, you might consider it a very impressive little phone, which will most probably be a tremendous hit in kid fashion stores. Do not be fooled though! It is a very serious contender to all fashion phones that roam the mobile phone market these days, and I won't be surprised if super models will make it a must have in today's fashion world.
