[Corsair Launches Fully Buffered 667MHz 2GB/4GB Memory Kits for Mac Pro](#)

Upgrade kits are available immediately from Corsair's authorized distributors and resellers world-wide

Corsair, well known for producing high performance computer and flash memory products, such as the memory stick you carry around in your pocket all day, has rolled out its new **high-density Memory Line for Mac Pros**. Corsair confirms that Mac Pro fully-buffered Memory Modules are immediately available in the form of a 2GB Kit - 2 x 1GB modules ((VSA2GBFBKIT667D2) for \$165 USD and a 4GB Kit - 2 x 2GB modules (VSA4GBKITFB667D2) for \$225. In addition to the new Corsair Mac Pro desktop line of memory products, the company responsible for computer memory, primarily for the computer enthusiast crowd has also launched the first [high performance memory modules](#) made especially for Mac laptops recently. They are the industry's first low latency modules specifically aimed at the latest MacBooks and MacBook Pros.
