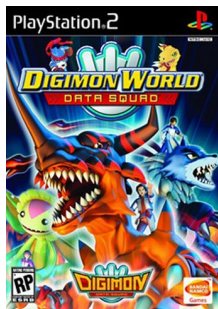

Learn the weaknesses of all Digimons

Digimon World Data Squad is a videogame created and published by Namco Bandai Games. It was created exclusively for the PlayStation 2 console from Sony. It was launched in November 2006 in Japan and in September 2007 in the United States. The title is classed as an action adventure game that combines some role playing game elements with action sequences. It is based on a popular anime franchise that is similar to the more popular Pokemon one.

Digimon World Data Squad allows players to experience the adventures of Marcus Daimon, Thomas H. Norstein, Yoshino "Yoshi" Fukieda and Keenan Crier as they are joined by their Digimon partners in an effort to fight against the Seven Great Demon Lords. The role playing aspects of the release appear as the Digimon evolve in the game depending on how the player interacts with them. The evolution system used is called Galactica Evolution System and players will be able to meet characters and Digimon that can be found in the anime extensions of the Digimon World Data Squad universe.

The plot is based on an attempt by the Seven Great Demon Lords to take over the Digimon universe by kidnapping very gifted children. As always, the task of saving the world is up to the Savers characters that the player can control. The game is actually a series of encounters with different hostile Digimons that need specific tactics in to be defeated. A player has to be familiar with the franchise on which the game is based in order to fully grasp the intricacies of the game.

GAMEPLAY HINTS

Weaknesses

Each Digimon has a Field Weakness. It is different from previous games in the series, where the strength or weakness was the attribute (Data, Vaccine, Virus). In this game, the Field Weakness (or Family) are as follows.

ME (Machine Empire): Most of them are Data or Virus. As the name implies, the Digimons from this family are Machines or Cyborgs, but they can also be Mutant or Odd Digimons (for example, Hagurumon, Numemon, Monzaemon).

DS (Deep Savers): Most of them are Data. The Digimons from this Family are Aquatic (for example, Otamamon, Tyromon, Whamon).
