Silverstar's Empire Interactive has announced that FlatOut is being prepared for a **PC** release this summer and this is the story that has just made my day, since the lack of really good **arcade racing** games for the personal computers was really annoying for me. FlatOut Ultimate Carnage will be released worldwide this June, so you can start the party right away! Bugbear Entertainment, the developers of FlatOut are working for the PC version and they promise to bring us a game that will visually rival the Xbox 360 version and this is a good thing to know. Also, if you really want to understand why I am so excited about this newly announced title, you should know that FlatOut was named the best Xbox racing game of 2006 and the franchise has sold over 2 million copies across the globe.
