If you're into [flight-simulators](#) I guess this fact sheet for Flight Simulator X: Acceleration Expansion Pack I just stumbled upon today will brighten your morning (that is, if you live in an area where it's still morning...). The game, developed by ACES Studio and published by Microsoft's Game Studios, still has to be rated, but that won't stop you from imagining how it's going to be when it's released. First things first, though.
