Everybody would rather hear that we know the date when [Gears of War 2](#) will be released, but this is not the case. However, we have something that might be a subtle hint about the long awaited sequel's arrival. Or it could be nothing more than it is. Ladies and gentleman, Gears of War action [figures](#) will hit the market soon! The National Entertainment Collectibles Association (NECA) has announced that in the late spring of 2008 fans all over the world will be able to play again with Marcus Fenix, Augustus Cole, and the villainous Locust Drone. Not in the sequel, as we'd all want, but with some very detailed action figures featuring extensive articulation and game-accurate accessories. Indeed, as you can see in the upper left corner, the action figures are really looking great.
