After washing your face, moisturize your skin and apply a special cream around your eyes too in order to ensure an even, fresh-looking skin all-round. It's time to add the foundation - go for a medium-coverage firming brand (Estee Lauder Resilience Lift Extreme Ultra Firming Makeup is a good option) and use a concealer if you need one, but go for a creamy brand in order to blend it in nicely with the rest of your makeup. Next, apply a very small amount of powdery blusher or bronzer on your cheeks, tracing the natural contour of your cheekbones. For your eyes, use a blend of champagne-colored eyeshadow (all over the upper lid) and a shimmery, copper color into the crease above each eye. Blend a black eyeliner into both the lower and upper lashes and apply two coats of black mascara. Finally, for your lips use a combination of pink lipstick topped up with a shimmery golden gloss (the Dior Addict Ultra Gloss Reflect is a good idea), and you're ready to get the party started.
