The Lost Crown: A Ghost-hunting [Adventure](#) was initially planned for a November release but, as you can see, nobody's playing it. Not because it's that bad - because the developers didn't manage to [finish it in time](#), the game's publishers said. However, there are promises that the spooky adventure will now be ready in time and released early 2008. The game is being developed by Jonathan Boakes and his Darkling Room team and it is about, as the name suggests, about ghost-hunters Nigel Danvers and Lucy Reubans as they unravel an ancient mystery and search for hidden treasures on England's coastline, famed for its legends of smugglers, pirates, and ghosts. "The developer was not able to deliver the game in the expected time-frame, but assures us that 'the end is in sight'," said Got Game Entertainment President Howard Horowitz.
