The singer/actress talks about her latest album

Although this hasn't been exactly Hilary Duff's year, either professionally or on a more personal level, the talented singer and actress is back on the scene. From all the so-called 'failures' comes her latest studio album, called 'Dignity' and she was kind enough as to talk about it to Ryan Seacrest on KISS FM. What went wrong?
