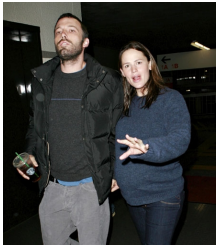

"Alias" star has just welcomed a healthy baby girl, it has been confirmed. Jennifer Garner gave birth to her second child on Tuesday, as her spokesperson informs People magazine. The pregnancy was first made official to the media in the summer of 2008, by Jennifer's former "Alias" co-star and best friend Victor Garber.

Although no other details have been made public so far, it is believed that both the child and the new mommy are doing well, and are in perfect health, somewhere at a Los Angeles clinic. The wedding was officiated by none other than Victor Garber himself, close friend of Jennifer's and also the same to reveal to the media her second pregnancy.
