Judge Signs Brad Pitt And Jennifer Aniston Divorce Papers

Although a judge has signed off on the divorce of Jennifer Aniston and Brad Pitt, the couple's split won't be official until Oct. 2, according to court records obtained Monday (AP).

Retired Judge Jill S. Robbins, whom the stars had sought to handle their breakup privately, approved the divorce papers Aug. 19 in Los Angeles Superior Court. Although the judge has signed off on the divorce of Jennifer Aniston and Brad Pitt, the couple's split, after 4 and a half years of marriage, won't be official until Oct. 2, according to court records obtained Monday (AP). Jennifer Aniston has recently confessed she still loved Pitt but she was trying to get on with her life.
