French actress Julie Delpy, 35, joins the ensemble cast of director Lasse Hallstrom's upcoming drama Hoax, according to the The Hollywood Reporter. The movie, based on Bill Wheeler's script, will be distributed by Walt Disney Studios. The story revolves around Clifford Irving, the man who wrote and sold a bogus biography of Howard Hughes to McGraw-Hill.
