After this year's April rumor about a [Benq-Siemens](#) codename "Ruby" mobile phone project, they are at it again. Pictures of a mobile phone concept, the so-called "Black Box" project, are spread through the world wide web with the speed of lightning (actually with the speed of the electric current, light or radio waves that carry all the information across the internet).
