Juventus boss seems to have been involved in arranging matches in Serie A

The Italian Football Federation announced today that they will open an investigation concerning Juventus boss, Luciano Moggi. The reason? Yes... you guessed right. The involvement in choosing refereeing for his team in Serie A matches. It was no secret for the football fans, especially the ones in Italy, that Juventus were given a little push by the referees to win titles in the Serie A. Well now it's official.
