Madonna Defends Tom Cruise

The Queen of Pop believes that Scientology is not hurting anybody

Madonna has jumped to defend Tom Cruise, after witnessing the harsh critics received by the actor over his controversial Scientology beliefs. The Queen of Pop, who also deals with critics over her following of the Kabala, believes that media should respect everyone's religion. Cruise has been speaking more openly about his love for the Church of Scientology and has converted his pregnant fiancée Katie Holmes. He is also raising his kids as Scientologists and fired his publicist to hire his Scientologist sister instead. "I find it very strange that it's (Scientology) so disturbing to people.
