[Manhunt 2 Hits North American Retailers - PS2, PSP and Wii](#)

Controversial horror title is finally out for home entertainment systems

Those who've watched the evolution of [Manhunt 2](#) since it was first rated by boards such as the [BBFC](#), ESRB and PEGI, probably lost all hope of seeing a typical Rockstar violent title hitting their systems. Well, as it turns out, the developer has confirmed the game's presence on North American retailers' shelves for the [PlayStation 2](#), [PlayStation Portable](#) and [Nintendo Wii](#). If you can remember, the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC) has banned the sadistic game not once, but twice in its revamping process. RockStar said they'd rather not change the game's code much even if that meant that Europeans weren't getting it on consoles. As for the Americans, the ESRB said it would be alright for the game to hit home entertainment systems and that's why you can go over to the store and get it for your personal collection.
