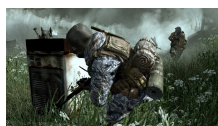

It seems to be "Trailer Monday" today, since we've just watched the newest BioShock 60 seconds stunner and now we're getting ready for a fast-paced multiplayer trailer from the latest [Call of Duty](#) game. The 2 minute trailer is called "Ghillie in the Mist", focusing on the Ghillie suit and shows what many of you FPS fans will be doing in your winter holiday. Let me remind you that the era of COD 2 and 3 has set and you're dealing with modern war now and all the tricks of Modern Warfare. Unofficial reports state that the launch date for Call of Duty 4 is November 9 on the PC, PS3 and Xbox 360, but Activision didn't confirm it yet.
