Horror expansion to hit stores this fall

If you're into [horror games](#) and especially if you loved Penumbra: Black Plague, you will be really excited to find out that the release date of the expansion is now set: the 27th of August 2008. Named Penumbra: Requiem, has been developed by Frictional Games and it will be available exclusively via digital download on website GamersGate.
