## [Runescape Goes HD](#)

*The popular MMORPG looks better starting today!*

Runescape is a game so good, addictive and popular that it can be compared, when it comes to the number of players, to World of Warcraft - [Jagex's](#) game has around ten million active accounts registered. The biggest difference between this massively multiplayer online game and WoW is the fact that most of these active members are playing for free, while only about one million are paying a subscription fee. However, it is still one of the most appreciated MMO titles ever released.

But if you are a Runescape player, you probably know that the game has one huge flaw: it looks awful. Yes, it is a Java based game, yes, it moves very fast because of its graphics and yes, the gameplay matters the most, but some better graphics can't be refused if they're offered to us, right?
