Z330, a New Phone from Samsung

The phone features GPRS and UMTS

It seems there is no end to the constant releasing of cellphones by [Samsung](#), one of the leading companies in this field. Z330 is one of the new handsets announced at the 3GSM convention in Barcelona. The model is a clamshell phone, weighing only 85 grams, with a thickness of 21 mm. Although small, it provides a great amount of storage space via the 140 MB internal [memory](#), which can be expanded even further. Among the endowments which have become standard among the new releases there are a [MP3](#) player and a 1.3 megapixel [camera](#). The cellphone supports the sending and receiving of [e-mails](#) through POP3, SMTP and IMAP4 protocols. Bluetooth is another useful addition for connectivity purposes. The Z330 is tri-band GSM (900/1800/1900 Mhz) and has GPRS and [UMTS](#) capabilities, which ensure high data transfer speeds. The mobile is scheduled for launch in the second quarter of 2006. [Samsung](#) has not disclosed information about the price.
