### *Part of a new deal with MTV*

Snoop Dogg said after signing the contract.

While a lot of details were revealed about the TV show, entitled Dogg After Dark, which will feature interviews, sketch-comedy and musical performances from Snoop's very own band, the Snoopeadelics, sadly, not a lot was said about the Rock Band partnership.

All that's left for us to do is watch the show every Tuesday and hope that MTV or Harmonix will soon reveal some details about the contribution of the famous rapper, who has been singing and entertaining from 1992 onward, to the popular [Rock Band](#) series. One thing's for sure though, if tracks from Snoop Dogg are to appear, then the game will be in for a massive boost in popularity.
