From then on, you only need to use your card at least once a month (make a purchase or load a balance). As long as you do this, every day means 2 free hours of Wi-Fi goodness at the Starbucks coffeehouse. Isn't life grand? You don't need your Starbucks Card to get online, all you need is your 802.11 device. As long as you've used your card in the last 30 days, the AT&T username and password you will create (as part of the registration process) is all you'll need each time you visit a Starbucks and want to wirelessly access the web or chat with your friends. So, in the simplest words possible, here's what you need to do to start enjoying your privileges as a Starbucks customer: **1** - Buy a Starbucks Card (if you already have one, you're good for step #2); **2** - Register your card online to create Starbucks.com and AT&T WiFi accounts; **3** - Go to Starbucks and sign in to your AT&T account to access Wi-Fi.
