The manufacturer claims that the scratching of an actual turntable is reproduced quite well by the SPIN wheel positioned in the center of the iPod DJ Mixer for easy access with both hands. From what the pictures show, the iPod DJ Mixer boasts a rather solid construction, despite its all-plastic body. Additional jacks will let you interconnect this mixer with a computer for both recording and playback. The iPod DJ Mixer obviously sports a headphone jack so you can act and look like a serious DJ.
