### *Dapper Drake Final*

The final version of Ubuntu Dapper Drake has been released today, a few minutes ago, to mirrors around the world. Ubuntu 6.06 will be supported for 3 years on the desktop and 5 years on server systems. Also Kubuntu, Edubuntu and Xubuntu distributions have been released along with Ubuntu Dapper Drake. As usual, it comes for three architectures, x86, AMD64 and PPC, with Install CD and Live CD and Server CD editions. Kubuntu comes with KDE 3.5.2 and includes a new installer which you can use directly from the live desktop CD.

**About Ubuntu:** Ubuntu is a complete Linux-based operating system, freely available with both community and professional support. It is developed by a large community and we invite you to participate too! The Ubuntu community is built on the ideas enshrined in the Ubuntu Philosophy: that software should be available free of charge, that software tools should be usable by people in their local language and despite any disabilities, and that people should have the freedom to customize and alter their software in whatever way they see fit. Ubuntu is suitable for both desktop and server use. The current Ubuntu release supports PC (Intel x86), 64-bit PC (AMD64) and PowerPC (Apple iBook and Powerbook, G4 and G5) architectures.
