If you're looking for an MP3 player to fit in your wallet, then the USB Flash Card MP3 Player should be the perfect device. It is not only fashionable and stylish, but it can also be used as a Mass Storage Device. The best thing about it is the fact that it is just about the size of a credit card, so it can easily be kept in a pocket. Just to make an idea about it, I should tell you the player measures 85.5x54x4.5mm and weighs no more than 20 grams. It is compatible with Windows 98SE/ME/2000/XP, Linux or Mac OS, so there should be no problem at all. Plus, the USB Flash Card Mp3 player is slim, light and goes hidden in any type of wallet, so it can be customized to suit all the user's tastes. When it doubles as a Mass Storage Device, all the data and info you need is going to be with you whenever you go and whatever you need. All the user has to do, is plug it into the USB port, and the PC will automatically detect and then configure it, without the need of restarting your PC. Regarding the tiny player capabilities, it can support MP3 and WMA file formats. It is powered by a built-in rechargeable battery. Not to mention it comes with an integrated 2GB of storage space, USB charge option, as well as sync cable, AC adapter and a pair of earphones, which can be replaced with your favorite ones. And don't worry, in case you run out of battery, there is a built-in LED which lights when it runs out of juice. However, in case you want to purchase this type of MP3 player, you can do it directly from the manufacturing company's web store, for a starting price of about 42 bucks a pop.
