The GDrive has been identified as Platypus project

The Mountain View Company has neither denied nor confirmed the speculations that will have it involved with the creation of an online storage service named GDrive. And such a strategy may prove to be an effective publicity technique as yet since information seems to surface more and more and bringing actual details about Google possible plans.
