RPG fans finally get a glimpse at Namco's highly anticipated RPG

Namco Bandai of America has recently made the exciting announcement that they've released the official demo for Eternal Sonata, on [Xbox LIVE](#). Silver and Gold members (oi thank you...!) are able to get the much anticipated demo via Xbox LIVE's Marketplace. The full game launches September 17th this year, for [Microsoft's Xbox 360](#). Eternal Sonata follows the adventures of famed composer Frederic Chopin as he travels through a mysterious world where the lines between dreams and reality are blurred, goes the game's official description. Featuring an innovative hybrid real-time and turn-based combat system, lush environments, and an epic storyline of redemption and self-discovery, Eternal Sonata sets itself apart from all other role-playing game experiences on the Xbox 360 video game and entertainment system from Microsoft. At the E3 Business & Media Summit this year, Eternal Sonata was nominated by the E3 Game Critics Awards for Best Role-Playing Game.
