Better Bookmarks, Better Toolbar

The Sunnyvale Company has debuted overhauled beta versions of Yahoo Toolbar for Internet Explorer and Yahoo Bookmarks. Designed to integrate with the final version of Internet Explorer 7, the Yahoo Toolbar 7.0 Beta is incompatible with IE7 Beta and with Windows Vista Beta.
