Google now working on new appearance

Following the recent improvements rolled out for the YouTube video watch page, the online video sharing service is now working on a brand new interface for the entire website. Yesterday, the YouTube Team presented a preview page of the new appearance, revealing several elements which might appear in the final version of the service. Personally, I really don't like the new YouTube because the red bar doesn't seem to fit the rest of the page while the menus are really annoying. Moreover, some of the drop-down menus are pretty buggy as you can see in the picture attached to the article. I know it is only an early preview so I guess the employees will fix it soon.
